



WHY NOW MR McGOWAN?

For over 20 years **WA Labor has continually opposed** WA's broadacre cropping, grazing and pastoral industries being included under the Agriculture Produce Commission (APC).

Yet Minister MacTiernan has recently **introduced legislation** that will remove this exemption, **with no consultation** with the majority of WA's 7,000 broadacre farmers, graziers and pastoralists.

These are just some of the issues in the *Agricultural Produce Commission Amendment Bill* that WA Labor have refused to ask you if you support.

What does Mark McGowan and Alannah MacTiernan NOT want you to know about the APC?

Don't let your industry be taken for granted. **Tell your Member of Parliament NOW that you don't want broadacre included under the APC.**

They have refused to ask if you support:

- The introduction of **an open ended State based fee for service** in your industry that will **duplicate your MLA, GRDC, AWI and IFS levies.**
- The introduction of **compulsory membership** in a committee, with **no guaranteed opt out provision.**
- The introduction of **APC compliance officers** who will be able to **enter your property without a warrant and demand your records.**
