

# Student Travel Assistance 2010

A fares allowance is provided to students living within the <u>Defined Remote Area</u> but who elect to attend a recognised school, college or university outside the <u>Defined Remote Area</u>.

The Student Subsidised Travel Scheme (SSTS) provides the following travel assistance between home and school by regular passenger transport (air, rail or bus):

- Primary & secondary school with 4 return trips per calendar year
- First year tertiary students, under 20 years of age, who have not previously been assessed for the SSTS, to receive 4 trips per calendar year
- First year tertiary students, under 20 years of age, who have previously accessed the SSTS, to receive 3 return trips per calendar year
- All other tertiary students to receive 2 return trips per calendar year
