Pastoralists will be given the option of having their lease renewed on its existing terms or by signing an alternate modern lease renewal instrument following the Government's release of the long awaited 2015 Lease Renewal Options paper.

The PGA has sent out a Briefing Overview to all members on the renewal options, and encourage pastoralists to seek independent legal and financial advice in regards to their own pastoral lease renewal.
