James Point P/L was selected by the government to build, own and operate a new port at Kwinana. The port would be fully funded by the private sector. Despite this and EPA approval, this major facility still awaits the final government go-ahead.

A land backed facility within a heavy industry precinct surrounded by a buffer zone has much to recommend it and it is hard to understand why it is not under construction. Bryn Martin will be speaking in the afternoon at the PGA Convention on Fri 25 Feb and will explain the lengthy history of the project and where it is at today. Bryn Martin is Chief Executive of James Point P/L and has been steering the project through changes of government and regulatory hurdles.
