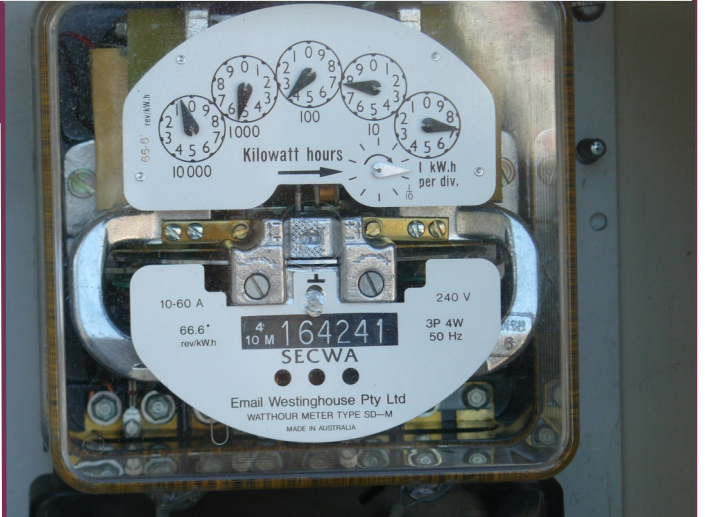
What is the purpose?
